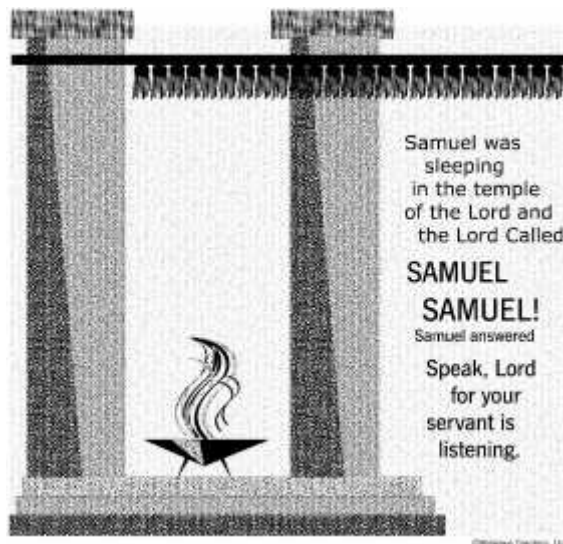

St. Paul Street Evangelization Volunteer Training

If you are like most Catholics, the idea of evangelizing makes you very nervous or you think of someone shouting at people on the street corner, asking if they are saved. This is not effective evangelization. St. Paul Street Evangelization is about sharing the Catholic Faith we love and helping others to find or rediscover that same Faith. The Second Vatican Council urges the baptized "to bring the Gospel, found fully in the Catholic Church, to a culture that has largely reverted to paganism."

You don't have to know all the answers to evangelize. Learn how to evangelize in a non-confrontational way, offering others rosaries or Miraculous Medals and resources. We give you the tools you need to build a bridge of trust between the streets and the parish.

Servants of Shelter, Opportunity to Volunteer

In response to homelessness in Bemidji, Servants of Shelter was formed by several churches in Bemidji to provide safe nighttime shelter to the homeless, as well as three meals a day. Each week, the shelter moves from church to church and can host up to 20 homeless people at a time. All of the guests go through a background clearance so that volunteers and guests can be given the best assurance of personal safety.

For many years, St. Philips has served as a host to the Servants of Shelter program. This year the SOS calendar did not coincide with our St. Philip's School calendar, so we are hosting/providing the volunteers for a week but at a different church location. **This year St. Philip's will host from February 11 through Feb 18th at Mt. Zion Church, 414 Lincoln Ave. SE.** (in Nymore, the old Lincoln School Building).

Guests arrive at 4:00 each afternoon and leave at 8:30 in the morning. We schedule our volunteers for **four hour shifts**, and have two volunteers on each shift. That means that we need no less than 8 volunteers each day of the shelter, plus people to provide meals. We are proud to say that we have a long list of parishioners that have filled shifts over the years, and we consistently receive a yes when we call them to work each year. However, we always need a new group of volunteers to cover this great ministry.

If you are willing/able to volunteer, please contact Kay Mack at 556-3031 or Paula DeClusin at 368-1081. We will do everything we can to find a shift that works well for you. We will also have sign-up sheets after Mass on the weekend of January 27 and 28.



An experience in Christian community

The Koinonia weekend is designed to help men and women grow in understanding, appreciation and experience of God, Jesus, Faith, Church, Ministry, Scripture and Self. It is a weekend of talks, discussion, reflection, sharing, prayer and liturgical celebration.

Participants in a Koinonia weekend must be at least 18 years of age (either single or married). Representation of all ages: 18 to 90+ provides for a richer experience for all who attend. Married couples may attend the same weekend, however, it is not a requirement.

Your weekend with the Lord begins with supper on Friday at 5:00 PM and ends on Sunday around 5:00 PM. Please plan on spending some quality time with members from your faith community. Casual clothes are worn throughout the weekend and all meals are provided. The weekend schedule is as follows:

Friday (5:00 PM – late evening), Saturday (8:00 AM – late evening), Sunday (8:00 AM – 5:00 PM), the weekend of February 9th-11th, 2018.

The cost of the weekend is only \$30 per person, which includes all supplies needed, as well as meals. Can't afford the cost? There are scholarships available, just write "scholarship" on the registration form; your confidentiality will be respected.
