4th Sunday of Ordinary Time greetings,

January 28, 2018

What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? That is a great question. I can tell you for myself and many of the pilgrims to Israel: Jesus and the biblical stories came alive. We have our modern-day thought, culture and understanding of the stories. But when you visit the Holy Land and you stand where Jesus might have stood, you see the hills, the greenery, the farmland, the archaeological digs, the impressive city of Jerusalem with its temple, the humbleness of Bethlehem, the Sea of Galilee, and the sepulcher: modern thought and understanding of the stories change.

What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? In Matthew chapter 5 Jesus delivers the Sermon on the Mount starting with the Beatitudes: "Blessed are they" ... when in Israel I found the setting so peaceful, green, lush even in winter. The monastery built on the site invites you to contemplate deeply the words Jesus proclaimed. We gathered in one of the several altar areas to hear the passage and then the several members of the group wandered or sat in the beautiful gardens to contemplate. It was amazing to feel the words as if they were expressed by Jesus himself in our day, our time.

What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? That is a great question. Personally, I discovered a renewed and deepened interest in Lexio Divina. Lexio is the practice of seeing the situation in which Scripture is proclaimed. It involves envisioning the surroundings, the people, their posture and then hearing the words in that setting. The second way Lexio works is to listen for a phrase that captures our imagination and then pondering that phrase.

What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? We know we are called to be disciples, and children of God anticipating the kingdom of heaven both here on earth and in the next life. We are challenged to be people of truth, compassion, kindness and love. In some instances of our lives that would require a radical change. Family members who are in strife called to honor and respect each other. When dealing with someone who has hurt us by word or action, separating the offensive act from the person. Like Jesus we love the dignity of the person but can call to task their action. Which may mean: forgiving someone not once, or twice but 77 times.

What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? I would like to invite you to a recap of the trip to Israel. Both Luke, our youth minister, and myself would love to share items we brought back from Israel, pictures of places we visited, and stories of our interaction with the Holy Land. We have set a date of Tuesday, February 20 following the 12:10 PM Mass during the soup luncheon. Hopefully the items I purchased and had shipped from Israel will be here in time for the meeting. I will also have salt from the Dead Sea, holy water and baptismal gown from the Jordan River, a copy of scrolls used in the temple, and some olive wood from Bethlehem.

While in Israel: we were safe and could feel God's protection over our group. We prayed daily for all our friends and family here at home. It feels great to be home... but, a part of me wants to return to Israel to experience the Bible coming to life... Jesus loves you and so do I...

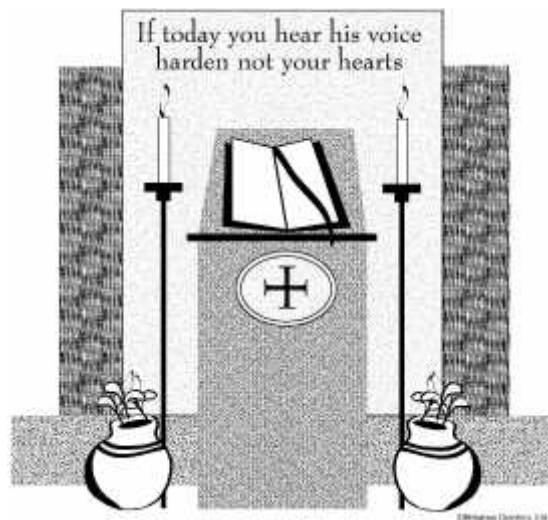
