## MY TWO CENTS by Fr. Don Braukmann

March 4, 2018

March. Hard to believe! Lent "marches" on!

Don't miss the "Eucharistic Miracles Exhibit" present at St. Philip's the weekend of March 16 to March 18. The bread and wine we offer at Mass truly become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. It is so because Jesus said it was so at the Last Supper! If you need more evidence of this miraculous truth, check out the exhibit.

The exhibit opens at 6pm on Thursday, March 15<sup>th</sup> with an official presentation at 7 PM. Friday, March 16<sup>th</sup> the exhibit is open from 8 AM-8 PM with presentations made at 12:30, 4 and 7:15 PM. Saturday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, open from 9 AM-8 PM...presentations at 9:30 AM, 1:00, 4:30, 6:30 PM. Sunday, March 18<sup>th</sup> from 8 AM-11 AM with a presentation at 8:30 and another at 10:15 AM. Powerful evidence showing Christ is among us...and always has been!

We will also host the Deanery Reconciliation Day on Friday, March 16<sup>th</sup> from 7 AM-7 PM. Priests from the Deanery (neighboring Catholic Churches) will be here throughout the day to celebrate the Sacrament with folks from the region. Even if you have not experience this beautiful Sacrament in 30-60 years...give it a try. Just come with an open heart. There will be folks present to direct you to the priests and the priest will guide you through. Lay your burdens and struggles at the foot of the Cross and come to know Jesus in the healing he is eager to share with you!

A note to those who stepped forward last weekend to be prayer partners for our 2<sup>nd</sup> graders who are preparing for their First Holy Communion... It was tough to see so many "new" faces at Mass last weekend when the children were recognized before the congregation as they begin their journey to the altar. Prayer partners, as you pray for these children, drop them a note letting them know you hope to see them and their family at Mass each weekend as part of their preparation. (Of course, any parishioner can pray for or encourage a child, the list of those preparing were in last week's bulletin.) I can think of few things that makes a priest and those who work with the 2<sup>nd</sup> graders more sad than knowing the children are not coming to Mass because of the decisions made by their parents. The Eucharist is the source and summit of our lives as Catholic Christians. Please don't let our children's First Communion be their ONLY Communion until Confirmation. Please. Christ longs to gather his little ones at the altar where he gives up everything for them....everything!

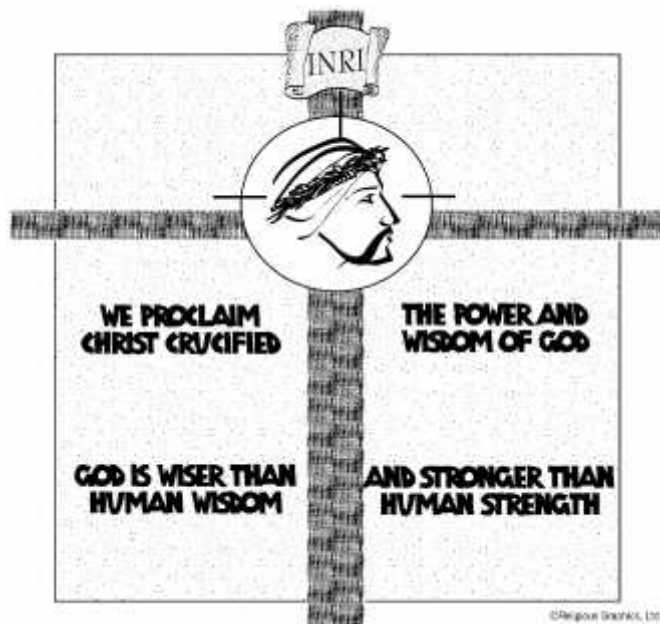

## The Real Presence?

Are you able to accept that the bread & wine become the actual body and blood of Jesus? Many have struggled with this belief, even some disciples of Jesus (read John 6:26-70). In 8<sup>th</sup>-century Italy the presiding monk asked God to help his unbelief. His prayers were answered when the bread & wine became actual flesh and blood during the consecration. This is miraculous in itself, but add to that the results of scientific testing conducted on un-preserved samples nearly 1200 years later. The flesh & blood contained proteins found in fresh, normal blood. The blood type was AB (universal receiver) matching the Shroud of Turin, and the flesh was determined to be heart tissue. ### Rotate to Donate

This March, the Bemidji Community Food Shelf (BCFS) is conducting a *Rotate to Donate* collection of these boxed or canned goods. Qualified staff will inspect each package to determine its viability before making the goods available to clients who depend on the BCFS to feed themselves and their families.



Last year the BCFS served 10,154 individuals and 11,282 families that included 16,326 individuals 17 years old or younger.

St. Philip's will participate in the *Rotate to Donate* project with collections held prior to Masses on March 24-25. Please open your cupboards during this Easter season and Rotate to Donate food. New packaged foods or monetary donations would also be welcome.
