Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

January 21, 2018

If only we were as quick to get out of bed when our alarm goes off, as the people of Nineveh were in responding to Jonah's alarm of their impending doom (*if they didn't change their ways*). And wouldn't it be great if it were as easy for us to decide on a new vocation, as it seems to have been for Simon and Andrew, and for James and John?

We respond to some alarms better than others ... and sometimes even to gentle nudges, more than loud attention-grabbers. For example, if the fire alarm goes off, we tend to take that seriously. And if a trusted friend gently but persistently nudges us to get help when we're in a bad place, we may take that seriously too. So, when it comes to making spiritual decisions in our lives, we might want to try to resist the temptation of becoming complacent about the alarms that go off in our hearts, or the nudges we get from God.

God's directions to us are rarely as pronounced as Jonah's warning, or Jesus' call to His first followers. God nudges us out of the way of spiritual calamity, but it's up to us to respond or not. If we don't accept God's nudging, we risk wrongdoing, or we may miss an opportunity to grow spiritually.

It's God who nudges us, not only away from trouble, but towards good. Again, however, it's our choice whether or not we allow ourselves to be moved. It's true that sometimes God gets our attention with an occasional "lightning bolt", but more often His prompting is more subtle. So, we have to pay close attention when we listen for God's voice and nudges.

While we all want happiness, God wants us to be happy too! We'll be happy if we respond with faith and love to the Lord's advice to come and follow Him. God knows our gifts, and how each of us fits into His plan for salvation. He inspires us to follow our heart's desire ... as engineers, laborers, teachers, clergy, civil servants, to name only a few. He wants us to have holy relationships, and to live holy lives.

So, while we're free to choose our own path, accepting a friendly nudge from the Lord can set us on the right path: a path that leads to happiness for us, a better world, and a path that leads to our eternal life with Him. Let us be watchful for those alarms, calls and nudges ... and be swift and joyful to respond to Him.

Servants of Shelter, Opportunity to Volunteer

In response to homelessness in Bemidji, Servants of Shelter was formed by several churches in Bemidji to provide safe nighttime shelter to the homeless, as well as three meals a day. Each week, the shelter moves from church to church and can host up to 20 homeless people at a time. All of the guests go through a background clearance so that volunteers and guests can be given the best assurance of personal safety.

For many years, St. Philips has served as a host to the Servants of Shelter program. This year the SOS calendar did not coincide with our St. Philip's School calendar, so we are hosting/providing the volunteers for a week but at a different church location. **This year St. Philip's will host from February 11 through Feb 18th at Mt. Zion Church, 414 Lincoln Ave. SE.** (in Nymore, the old Lincoln School Building).

Guests arrive at 4:00 each afternoon and leave at 8:30 in the morning. We schedule our volunteers for **four hour shifts**, and have two volunteers on each shift. That means that we need no less than 8 volunteers each day of the shelter, plus people to provide meals. We are proud to say that we have a long list of parishioners that have filled shifts over the years, and we consistently receive a yes when we call them to work each year. However, we always need a new group of volunteers to cover this great ministry.

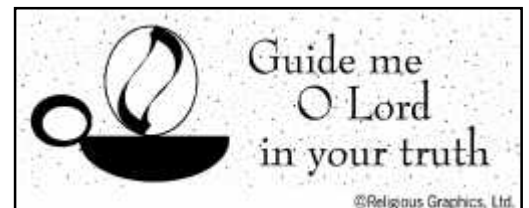
