Fourth Sunday of Lent Greetings,

March 11, 2018

“For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.” (John 3:16) What an awesome God we have! All we have to do is believe. Jesus took care of the rest! “For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not from you; it is a gift from God.” (Eph. 2:9)

I pray that your Lenten journey is going well and that you are experiencing an increase in prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Through this experience may you enjoy a closer walk with Jesus.

The forty days of Lent seem to go by so quickly and we will soon be coming to the week that highlights the church year. Beginning two weeks from today with Palm Sunday when we walk with Jesus on his triumphant entry to Jerusalem and continue with him all the way to the cross. I would like to encourage you to make plans now to partake fully in the events of Holy Week. This may mean spending quite a bit of time at church during the week, however, I cannot think of a better place to be during Holy Week. Each and every celebration is special.

Monday, March 26th, at 6:30 PM is the Chrism Mass at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Crookston. During this Mass, Bishop Hoepfner will bless the Oil of the Sick & the Oil of Baptism and consecrate the Sacred Chrism which we will use for each baptism, confirmation and Anointing of the Sick here in our parish for the next year.

Thursday, March 29th at 7:00 PM is the Mass of the Lord's Supper. At this Mass we celebrate Christ's establishment of the Holy Eucharist as well as the washing of the disciples feet.

Friday, March 30th at both 3:00 PM and 6:30 PM, Good Friday, we will be able to venerate the cross and again take part in the reading of our Lord's passion.

Saturday, March 31st, at 8:30 PM we will celebrate the highlight of the church year, at the **Easter Vigil in the Holy Night of Easter.** This Mass may last close to two hours, but there is never a dull moment. We receive the new light of Christ, proclaim his resurrection, hear from scripture the whole story of salvation, baptize and confirm new members joining our parish family and share together in the Eucharist, proclaiming Christ the Risen King!

Sunday, April 1st, Easter Sunday Morning! Masses at 7:30 AM, 9:00 AM & 11:00 AM. To help ourselves be ready to truly celebrate Holy Week may we prepare well these last couple of weeks of Lent. This coming Friday, March 16th, is our day of grace. Priests will be available from 7 AM until 7 PM to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Stop in and have a conversation with Jesus. Remember, He loves you and wants to be your best friend. What an awesome God we have!
