

## GUIDELINES FOR THE RECEPTION OF COMMUNION

Because Catholics believe that the celebration of the Eucharist is a sign of the reality of the oneness of faith, life, and worship, members of those churches with whom we are not yet fully united are ordinarily not admitted to Holy Communion. We pray that one day our divisions will finally disappear, in keeping with Christ's prayer for us "that they may all be one" (Jn 17:21).

## LUNCH AFTER MASS AVAILABLE

The Patnode family has provided lunch for those attending the funeral Mass. You are welcome to stop in the social hall and pick up a lunch-to-go (sandwich, cookie/bar, fruit and water) to take with you. The family will return for lunch after the burial.


